Schools requiring Estyn monitoring following Section 28 inspection

As you know, a team of inspectors, led by Richard Hawkley, visited your school recently in order to monitor the progress made since the Section 28 inspection in March 2012.

Outcome of the monitoring visit

Myrddin C.P. School is judged to have made good progress in respect of the key issues for action following the Estyn visit in June 2013. We will now remove the school from the list of schools requiring Estyn monitoring. There will be no further Estyn monitoring visits in relation to this inspection.
